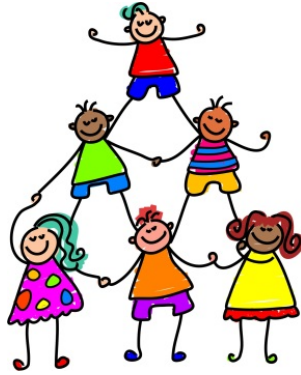
News and Notes
